



Radio Show

Explore the musical landscapes of the world of mandolin - new acoustic, classical, jazz, choro, swing, Americana, bluegrass, blues, rock, pop, surf, Cajun, contra dance, celtic, old-time, and gypsy-jazz. This show features music from the mandolin family and related instruments (domra, oud, bandolim, pipa, and more) from every continent, particularly America, Europe, India, Russia and Brazil, from the turn of the century, to music just released (or about to be)! This mix of music appeals to serious players of mandolin-family instruments, and well as folks who'd just like to hear music that swings, amazes, gives a chuckle, and inspires.

The Show

MandoScapes is a 90-minute all-mandolin radio program broadcasting from KRFC (88.9 FM) in Fort Collins, Colorado. MandoScapes is hosted by area mandolinists Ellen Audley and Brent Hawley and is broadcast both on the air and over the internet via streaming media. Show time is Monday mornings between 6:00 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. Mountain Time (GMT minus 7 hours). KRFC is a homegrown community radio station serving the needs of the northern Colorado region and the online community.

The name came about to describe the many musical landscapes of the mandolin. It could also be an Escape, or an Escape to the Landscapes as you prefer.

Listeners and fans of mandolin music from around the world are welcome and appreciated!

How the show generally works

Brent's show always has a "Tribute to Jethro Burns" at 7 a.m. MDT with clips from Homer and Jethro records and his personal Jethro Burns basement tape collection. Brent generally plays half hour segments starting with classical mandolin, then jazz and swing, followed by acoustic and bluegrass.

Ellen's show usually starts out with something dreamy and off the beaten track to make it easier to coax local listeners out of their beds and into their day. Generally, a different style of music is featured every 15 minutes, and the order of the genres varies with the show. It always includes Brazilian music. Doug Audley (married to Ellen) mixes in songs as he's inspired and keeps the note-density reasonable. A typical show might go: World/Jazz/Classical/Bluegrass & New Acoustic/Brazil/Blues and then fade into the news.

Thank you for listening to and supporting this 90 minutes of mandolin music! Brent and Ellen hope that you'll give feedback, ask questions, make suggestions and have fun being a part of this "mandolin radio" community.
